The efficient heating and air conditioning systems in the cabins keep the operators comfortable and safe while working in intense environments. Cabs are sealed to suppress sound and allow the operators to work at optimum performance levels. The hydraulics have been implemented to allow the operator to maintain control with precise joystick engineering to facilitate precise and predictable clamp positioning during radial and parallel operations. Arctic Package The Arctic Package is one of the many Special Feature Request that allows Dressta machines to perform at their maximum ability within difficult climate situations. Some of the popular Arctic Package components include fuel heating, cab heating, arctic cabs, oil heaters, an engine pre-heating system, additional lights for blizzard situations, push arms for dozers, ripper shanks, reinforced blades and steering levers that can accommodate heavier gloves. Application Customization Stockpile The stockpile compaction feature package has been created for Dressta's crawler dozer series to manage job situations that include sloped locations that are often unstable. This SFR equipment has a heavy-duty Dressta steel drum along with a winch line attachment with brackets attached to the drum. There is a tensioning apparatus that prevents the line from coming into contact with the slope face. These crawler dozers evenly distribute their weight to ensure stability and balance. Fire Tractor Dozers This range of tractor dozers are ideal machines for preventing, cleaning up and containing forest fires. These dozers are working around falling trees, heavy ash, dirt, airborne sand and burning sap. The fire crews rely on the dozers to remove combustible material, cut path and clear fire lines. The machine and operator are protected by a complete forestry cab kit complete with steel mesh screens, guards, metallic fire curtains and sweeps to prevent damage from falling trees. Special fire-resistant sheeting keeps the electrical components safe within the tractors and reinforced guards protect the hydraulic cylinders and the hoses. Winches, fire plows and bush blades comprise some of the additional attachments to tackle fires. Special features are

implemented to prevent overheating such as cooling modules for the powertrain, charge air and radiator and the direct drive powertrain. Belt Shifting Conveyor belts are used by mining applications to transport debris and minerals from the seam where they are found to different locations for reprocessing. The SB-85 Dressta model is commonly used for rapidly repositioning and realigning conveyor belts on the job site. This machine is commonly used in confined spaces and can be used to shift railway tracks. It features high ground clearance making it useful for difficult terrain and features a 2500mm belt width.
